History

On July 31, 2016, Rural Health Services Consortium, Inc. joined forces with The Inline Group (TIG). In need of a family nurse practitioner, a family medicine physician and a dentist, they engaged TIG to aid in that process.

Mountain City is a rural community with a population of almost 2,500. Given the fact that only about 600 families call Mountain City home, Rural Health anticipated that these searches might take a while to fill.

On August 18, less than a week after the introductory call, an FNP saw the job posted on one of our job boards and contacted TIG. The candidate actually lived about 90 minutes away and thought the opportunity was at the Kingsport location. However, Misty took the time to speak with the candidate and determined that Monna was a person they wanted in their facility. In the end, Rural Health found the right place for Monna and within 26 days of the introduction, the candidate was hired.
